

Miami County Raceway 2024 Rules

Track and Pit Rules

- 1. Pit Vehicles.** Anyone operating a golf cart, pit bike, 4 wheeler must be 16 yrs. of age w/drivers license. Indiana State Law requires riders under the age of 18 to wear a DOT approved helmet while operating an ATV. Golf carts may carry only the amount of people that the seating is designed for. Electric pit bikes are permitted, and the use of a helmet is strongly recommended.
- 2. Pit Speed.** No speeding in the pits. All cars and pit vehicles must maintain a consistent and safe speed. No swerving, wheelies, doughnuts, or erratic driving in the pits.
- 3. Pit Violations.** Violations for pit vehicle rules will result in loss of privileges and/or suspension. Warnings will be limited. Be safe and follow the rules!
- 4. Pit Spots.** Reserved pit spots will be available to purchase for the entire season. Reserved pit spots will be guaranteed until 6:00pm on race day. After 6:00pm, reserved pit spots will become available on a first come, first serve basis.
- 5. Spectating.** Spectators and Pit Crews must maintain a minimum distance of 12 feet between the outside wall or guardrail and their race viewing position. This includes grandstand, lawn chair, and standing areas. Standing against the fence while cars are racing will not be permitted.
- 6. Radio Communication.** One way radio communication between race control and the driver is mandatory. Radio communication between the pit crew and driver is prohibited.
- 7. Exiting the Track.** Once a car exits the racing surface it may not re-enter. The only exception is in the event of an altercation prior to the original green flag at race director's discretion. Maintain a safe and consistent speed while driving through the pit area. Speeding and erratic driving through the pits will result in immediate disqualification for the entire event!
- 8. Red Flags.** Red flags are closed unless stated otherwise.
- 9. Time Limits.** Races may be shortened for exceeding a time limit of 25 minute per each main event. Red flags will not count toward the time limit unless multiple red flags have occurred in a single race.
- 10. Spins.** There is 2-Spin Rule, however any driver causing extensive delays due to spinning or cautions may be black flagged at Race Director's discretion.
- 11. Scoring Tower.** Do not enter the scoring tower unless invited. If you have an issue with scoring or any incident within the facility, please find a track official. If you enter the scoring tower uninvited, you or your team will be disqualified for the night.
